September Stewardship Message

Whenever I see the words "Neighbors in Need" I first think back to the early 70's and a couple, Ken and Virginia Baxter, who started the Seattle Food Bank under that name to help recently laid off Boeing workers and others who were struggling to feed their families. UCC's campaign called Neighbors in Need focuses on different needs today, but they are just as important. The offering scheduled on the first Sunday in October (although contributions can be received anytime) is directed toward supporting ministries of justice and compassion throughout the United States. Two-thirds of this offering is used by the UCC's Justice and Witness Ministries to support a variety of justice initiatives, advocacy efforts, and direct service projects through grants. The remaining one-third of NIN funds support the Council for American Indian Ministry (CAIM), which helps support 20 UCC congregations on reservations and one urban, multi-tribal congregation in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

This is us in the UCC putting our inclusive and extravagant welcome messages about compassion and justice into action. Together we practice what we preach and make a material difference in people's lives.


Justice Leadership Program – Fall application deadline September 23rd
