# A FOUR-WAY MINISTRY COVENANT AMONG

# AUTHORIZED MINISTER CALLING BODY / EMPLOYER LOCAL CHURCH

#### PACIFIC NORTHWEST CONFERENCE

#### ABOUT THE FOUR-WAY COVENANT

The United Church of Christ advises that, in instances where Ordained Ministers are called to non-parish employment, a covenantal relationship be established among the Ordained Minister, the calling body, the United Church of Christ as represented by an Association or Conference, and the Local Church where the Ordained Minister is a member. This relationship is known as a four-way covenant. The purpose of this covenant is:

- 1. To strengthen, support and sustain the ministries of all the partners that share in this covenant.
- 2. To encourage mutual participation and accountability of and for the life of each by the others.
- 3. To observe, nurture, celebrate and call forth the ministry of the Ordained Minister.

#### **COVENANTS OF MUTUAL ACCOUNTABILITY**

#### Ordained Minister, as an Authorized Minister of the United Church of Christ covenants:

#### To Local Church United Church of Christ in City/State:

- Membership in good standing with <u>Local Church</u>, including financial support for the general ministries of this church, participation in the worshiping life of the church whenever possible, and a commitment to earnest prayer for the well-being of this congregation and its ministry.
- Submission of articles for the newsletter or other publications regarding <a href="his/her/their">his/her/their</a> ministry.
- An annual meeting with the Church Council or other representative to support one another in mutual ministry.
- A commitment to preach annually at the request of the pastor.
- Public recognition of membership in this Body of Christ in duties related to her/his/their ministry.

#### To the Pacific Northwest Conference (PNC)

- Participation in PNC Annual Meetings, Ministerium gatherings of the Conference and other events whenever possible.
- Adherence to Oversight by the PNC Committee on Ministry (COM), including submission of the Annual Information Review, the triennial Boundary Training, attendance at the Annual Meeting and other assignments as required by the COM.

#### Authorized Minister's Name

#### To the Calling Body/Employer:

- Faithfulness in the preaching and teaching of the Gospel, the exercise of pastoral functions, the administration of rites and sacraments of the Church, and in adherence to the Minister Codes of the Manual on Ministry.
- Fidelity to the terms of <a href="her/his/their">her/his/their</a> ministry and fidelity to the tasks of <a href="her/his/their">her/his/their</a> job description from the <a href="Calling Body/Employer">Calling Body/Employer</a> (attached), so long as <a href="Authorized Minister">Authorized Minister</a> serves as <a href="Title and Position">Title and Position</a> with <a href="Calling Body/Employer">Calling Body/Employer</a>.
   Obligations of compensation and employment exist exclusively between <a href="Authorized Minister">Authorized Minister</a> and the <a href="Calling Body/Employer">Calling Body/Employer</a>.

# **Local Church United Church of Christ, as the Local Church of Membership covenants:**

#### To Authorized Minister:

- Prayers for <u>her/his/their</u> work with the <u>Calling Body/Employer</u>.
- Inclusion of materials written by <u>Authorized Minister</u> in the congregation's newsletter and Annual Report.
- Public recognition of <u>Authorized Minister</u> as a Minister sent into the world on behalf of the <u>local church's name</u>.
- An annual meeting with the Church Council or other representative to support one another in mutual ministry.

#### To the Calling Body/Employer:

• Collection of an offering contributing to the work of the Calling Body or a similarly related ministry.

#### To the Pacific Northwest Conference

- Appropriate documentation of <u>Authorized Minister</u> as an Authorized Minister with Ordained Ministerial Standing in the Untied Church of Christ.
- Annual contributions to Our Church's Wider Mission (OCWM) in recognition of the role
  of the wider church in the formation and oversight of authorized ministers in the
  United Church of Christ.

#### The Pacific Northwest Conference of the United Church of Christ covenants:

### To Authorized Minister:

- All the rights and responsibilities of an ordained minister in the Pacific Northwest Conference of the United Church of Christ.
- Clear communication of this Conference's requirements for good ministerial standing (including but not limited to boundary training and continuing education) and of any policies and procedures supplemental to the Manual on Ministry that have been established by this Conference.

#### To Local Church, United Church of Christ:

 Appropriate support and oversight of all ministers in three or four-way covenants with your congregation.

#### **Authorized Minister's Name**

#### To the Calling Body/Employer:

 Inclusion of written updates from <u>Authorized Minister</u> regarding <u>her/his/their</u> work for the <u>Calling Body/Employer</u> to be placed in the minister's Ministerial files at the Pacific Northwest Conference office.

# **The Calling Body/Employer covenants:**

#### To Authorized Minister:

- Belief in God's call that has led <u>Authorized Minister's Name</u> to this particular place of ministry.
- Adherence to remuneration as set forth in the call agreement, common personnel policies, and current job description.

# To Local Church United Church of Christ in City/State:

• Belief in the local church as the locus for all ministry in the United Church of Christ and thankfulness for your support of Authorized Minister.

# To the Pacific Northwest Conference:

Fidelity to the covenants of mutual accountability as articulated in this document.
